Students nominated for Congress of Future Medical Leaders

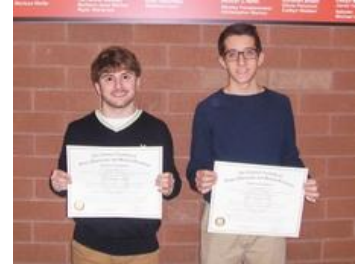
