Junior High Science Olympiad returns

MOSCOW – The North Pocono Junior High Science Olympiad Team has been reassembled from a five year break and they are having a blast! In their first invitational ever, the team prepared to compete in their STEM events at Bayard Rustin High School in West Chester on January 5, 2019. The team is composed of 7th, 8th,

and 9th grade students who are passionate about science, technology, engineering, and math. The team competed against 60 other junior high teams from the tristate area, some of which are national competitors.

In five of their events, the North Pocono Junior High Team placed in the top half of the teams present. The places in some of these events came down to a 1 point difference.

The competition is intense and the work to prepare is rigorous, but that doesn't stop these students. They meet at the highschool twice a week to prepare for their events with each other and their event mentors.

The students competed on January 26th at the North Pocono Invitational and will compete again in February at
